#### From the airport to hotel

The easiest option is to take the taxi (Airport Taxi Service) to the Varscona Hotel on Whyte Avenue (30min, \$55, keep a receipt). Justin Biddle and Nancy Potter are on the same flight into Edmonton, and thus could simply share a taxi.

There is also the SkyShuttle, which stops at the Varscona (for \$18), but this shuttle service departs the airport every hour only (at the full hour).

#### Hotel accommodation

Bookings under your name have been made at the Varscona Hotel on Whyte Avenue (8208 106 Street, Tel. 780-439-1195), and you will not be charged for the rooms. There is free wireless internet at the hotel.

#### Getting to campus

The building where the Wednesday keynote takes place as well as Assiniboia Hall (Thursday / Friday sessions) are a 30 minute walk from the Varscona Hotel.

If you to take a taxi, you should ask to be dropped off at the university's bus loop, close to the Student Union and St. Joseph's College.

There are also busses stopping in front of the Varscona, going westward to campus (#4 and #7 are the main lines, each departing every 15 minutes, #54, #94 and #926 go less regularly). The bus ride is not much longer than 10 minutes; get off at the University Transit Centre Stop, or already on the prior stop 114 Street & 89 Avenue (at St. Joseph's College). Bus fare is \$3.25, exact cash required.

#### **Conference dinners**

Both restaurants can accommodate vegans and celiacs. All workshop speakers will be covered by my SSHRC grant (excluding alcohol, according to SSHRC guidelines). Please let me know if you will not be attending one of the dinners.
