#### What is required from you:

• Attend a training session

Sunday, January 31 OR Wednesday, February 3

9am-5pm 4pm-9pm

We will introduce you to the rules of Canadian Parliamentary debating and teach you what to look for when judging a round. You'll then have a chance to judge a few rounds with experienced pros there to help you out.

#### • Come to a few practices

Wednesdays and Thursdays at 5:00pm in HC 2-11 (There will also be a few weekend practices.)

#### • Judge at Nationals

You must attend the briefings and all six rounds (i.e. Friday afternoon and evening, and all day Saturday). You are more than welcome to watch the elimination rounds on Sunday, but not required.

• Pay a registration fee before attending the tournament \$40 for judges who complete all the training requirements, and \$70 for those who don't Judges who do not wish to attend the banquet are not required to pay the full fee.

#### What you will get from the experience:

- Improved critical thinking and analytical skills, and increased awareness of current events
- A chance to watch, evaluate and criticize some of the brightest students in Canada, and to collaborate on adjudication panels with some more of them
- The opportunity hang out with these bright people from across Canada at social events throughout the weekend, including a black-tie banquet
- Tasty food for the whole weekend
- A compelling-looking addition to your resume
- A personal reference letter from the Director of Judges and Volunteers, upon request
