Basic Order Example

- Operator: Hello Pizza 73, may I take your order?
- You: I'd like to have a 14-inch Pepperoni pizza, and a 14-inch Hawaiian pizza.
- Operator: What dips or sides would you like with your order?
- You: I'd like 20 chicken wings. No dips please.
- Operator: Any drinks?
- You: I'll have a Large Coke please.
- Operator: Is that everything?
- You: Yes.

Basic Order Example

- Operator: What's your address? Phone #
- You: <say your address/phone #>
- Operator: The total comes to <total price of your order>. How are you paying?
- You: Debit / Cash / Credit card.

- Operator: It'll be there within 30 minutes.
 Thank you for ordering.
- You: Thank you, good bye.

Tips and Pointers

- If you don't understand the server's words, just ASK. ☺
- Read the restaurant's menu on the internet
- If server asks too early, tell him/her
 "Give me a few more minutes please."

Tips and Pointers

- If you want to stay longer after eating, tell your server
 - "Can we stay here longer?"
- Don't be nervous! You are a guest in the restaurant, and you are paying them money.
- PRACTICE! Get a friend to help you out first, and then slowly try it out by yourself.
