She discovered that when a human reproductive difficulty is recorded it appears only in association with the woman. Dr. Jones complains, "See, here is another example of patriarchal oppression against women. It is only women who are the problem when a reproductive difficult arises in the Bible—never men! However, modern medicine has proven that men can also be 'barren' and source of infertility." At that moment you are called to meet the dean and your response to Dr. Jones' complaint will have to wait. After some thought you believe the most appropriate response is a written one.
