



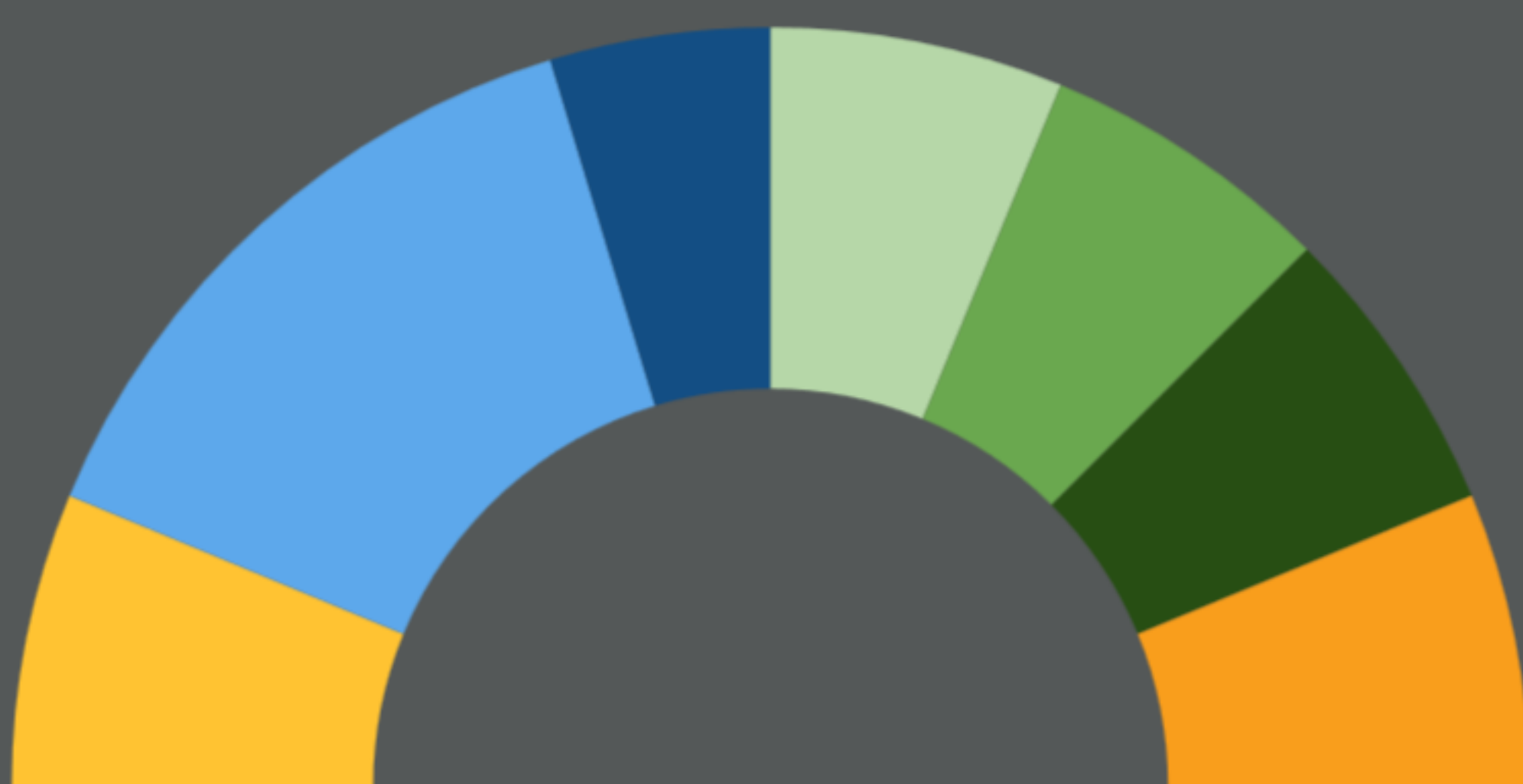
INTERPROFESSIONAL PATHWAY LAUNCH

Introduction establishes common understanding of the philosophy, language and expectation of IPE.

Student teams explore collaborative practice through experiential learning components:

- Clinical and communication scenarios
- Discussion stations hosted by patients, practitioners and regulatory bodies
- In the wrap up, students receive practical IP resources and teams are awarded prizes based on engagement

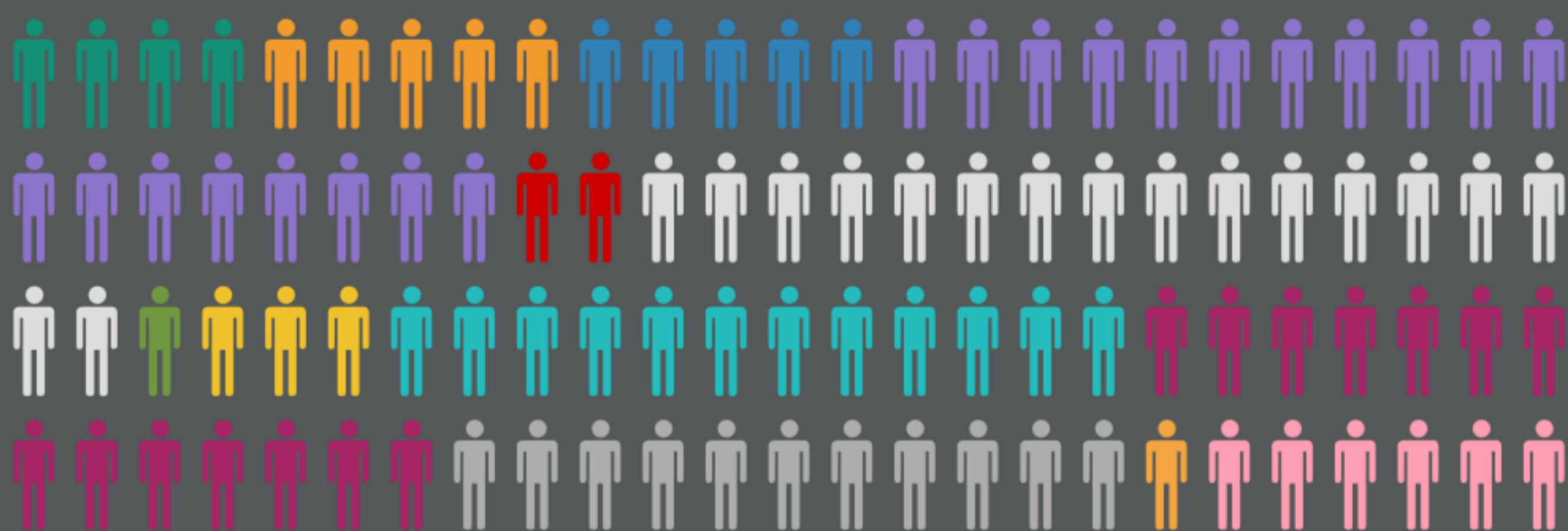
