INT D 410

Registration Information for Students Fall 2018 – Winter 2019

As of March 2018, Bear Tracks web-based registration for INT D 410 is open for Fall 2018 and Winter 2019. Health Science students must register into discipline-specific sections, which enables tracking the number of students from each discipline who register for the course at the various days/times that the course runs. Students from multiple discipline-specific sections will be combined to create interdisciplinary course groups.

There are 2 overall versions of INT D 410; both require the equivalent of 10 modules of work:

- Version 1 (INT D 410 A/B) spreads the work across fall and winter terms, for a lighter load in the winter term compared with the traditional winter-only version of the course.
- Version 2 (INT D 410) has all the course work compressed in the winter term only.

Bear Tracks section caps are setup such that about half of students will register in each of the 2 versions.

Version 1: INT D 410A & INT D 410B

- Also known as "Essentials of Collaborative Practice" (ECP) stream.
- Course spans across Fall 2018 & Winter 2019.
- The Fall term has no fixed class time, rather a combination of online work and variably scheduled face-to-face sessions, equivalent to a total of 3 modules of work.
- Requires attendance at the Interprofessional (IP) Launch on Friday, Sept 14 (choice of several different 3-hour timeslots, morning or afternoon); or students who have attended the IP Launch in a previous year get advance credit and do not need to attend again in Fall 2018.
- Requires attendance at a Fall 3-hour interprofessional learning experience, which students will select in Fall 2018 from a menu of options (students will be provided with a list of various date/time choices).
- Includes 6 face-to-face 3-hour classes in the winter term between Jan 8 & Mar 21, 2019, on a fixed day/time depending on the section in which you register.
- Requires attendance at the Help Save Stan simulation event, which will be a 3-hour experience on Saturday March 2, 2019. Note: Students have a week off of their regularly scheduled class in exchange for attending this event.

Version 2: INT D 410 Winter only

- This is the traditional course schedule, which includes 10 face-to-face 3-hour classes between Jan 8 & Mar 21, 2019, on a fixed day/time once weekly depending on the section in which you register.
- Web-based registration in Bear Tracks for INT D 410 (Winter term version) closes on Nov. 16, 2018, after which you must contact intd410@ualberta.ca to have the HSERC dept. register you in the course.
