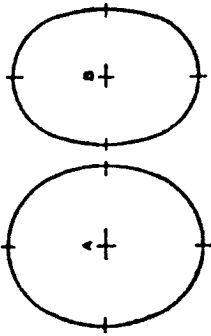
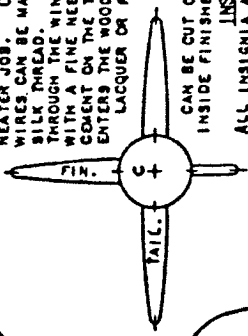


COLORS

 BALANCE OF FIN, RUDDER AND TAIL SKID
 FIN ARE WHITE. PROPELLER BLADES ARE
 NATURAL WOOD AND SPINNER AND NOSE OF
 FUSELAGE AND OUTLINED
 COILING AROUND MOTOR
 ARE WHITE. STRUTS,
 GUNS, MOTOR, WIRES,
 ETC., ARE BLACK.

PAINT ALL PARTS BEFORE THEY ARE
 CEVENED TOGETHER. THIS MAKES A
 NEATER JOB. CONTROL AND BRACE
 WIRES CAN BE MADE FROM VERY FINE
 SILK THREAD. PULL THE THREAD
 THROUGH THE WINGS AND OTHER PARTS
 WITH A FINE NEEDLE USING A LITTLE
 CEMENT ON THE THREAD WHERE IT
 ENTERS THE WOOD. USE BLACK INK,
 LACQUER OR FINE STRIPS OF BLACK
 TISSUE TO OUTLINE
 CONTROL SURFACES,
 ETC. THE COCKPIT
 CAN BE CUT OUT SHALLOW AND THE
 INSIDE FINISHED BLACK.
 ALL INSIGNIA ARE BLACK. USE
 WHITE OUTLINE EXCEPT ON RUDDER.
