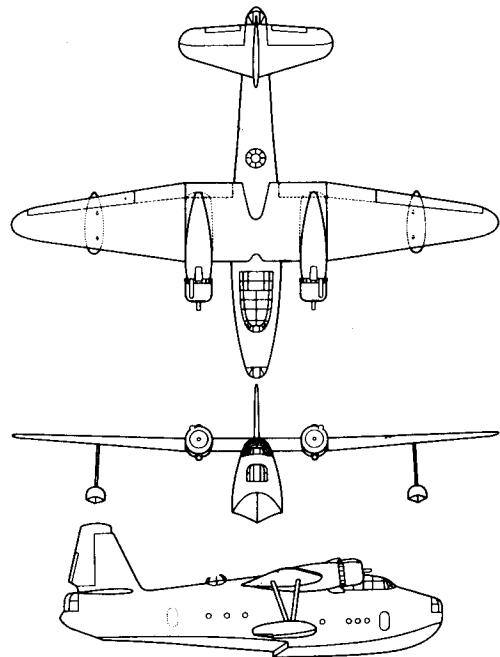
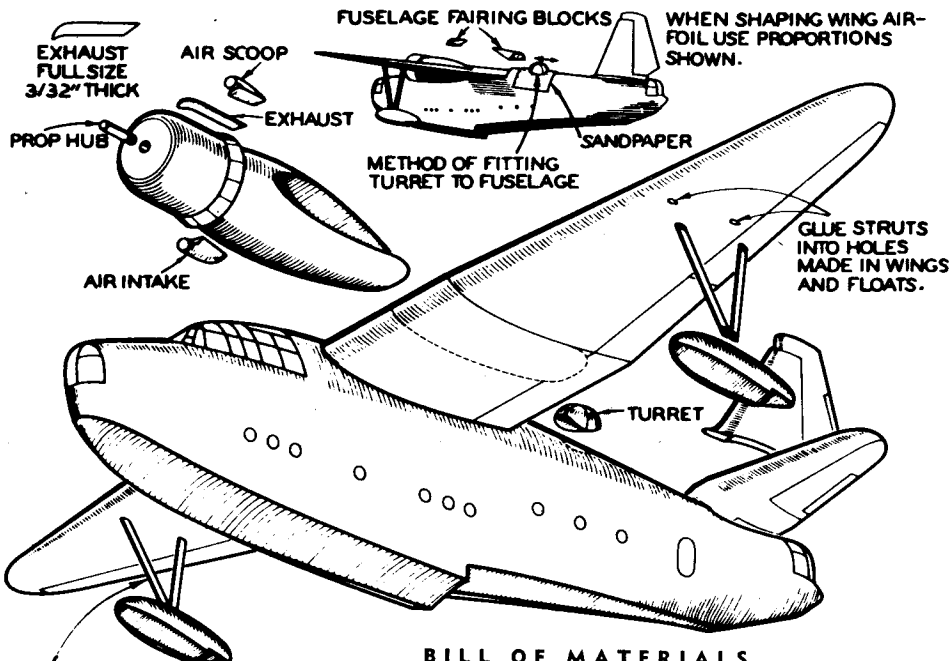
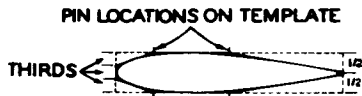


SARO "LERWICK"

The Saunders-Roe ("Saro") "Lerwick" is a British patrol bomber flying boat carrying a crew of seven. It has turrets in the nose, top of fuselage, and in the tail. Powered by two "Hercules" radial air-cooled engines. Span 80' 10"; length 63' 7".

Struts	1/16" x 1/8"
Turret	9/16" diam. x 5/16"
Propeller hubs	3/32" dowel
