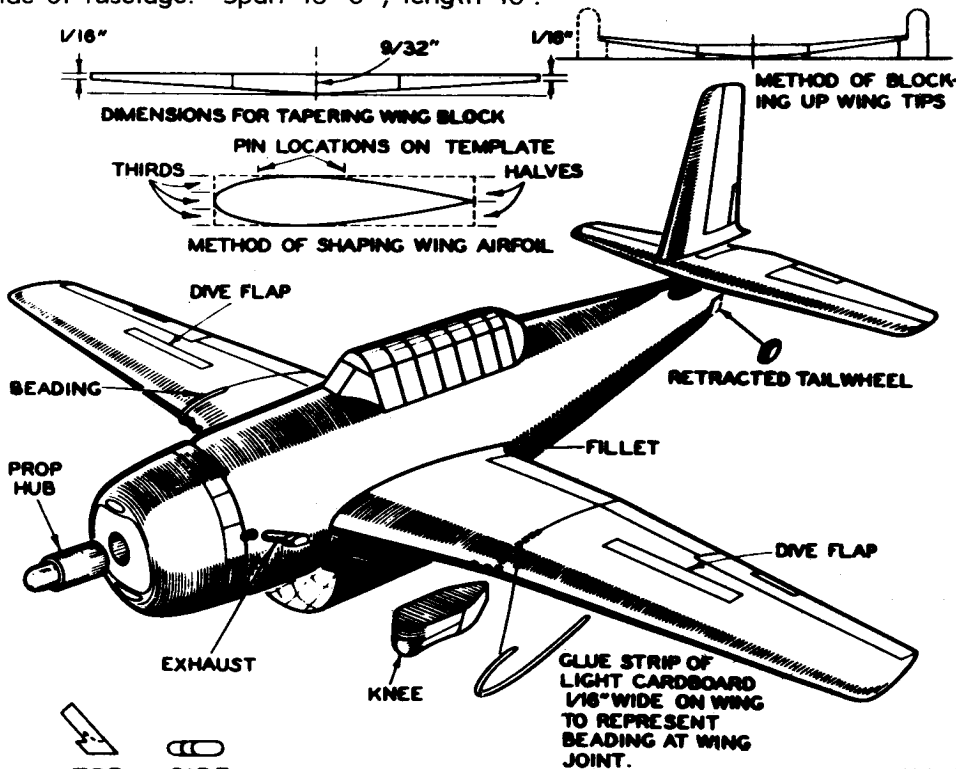
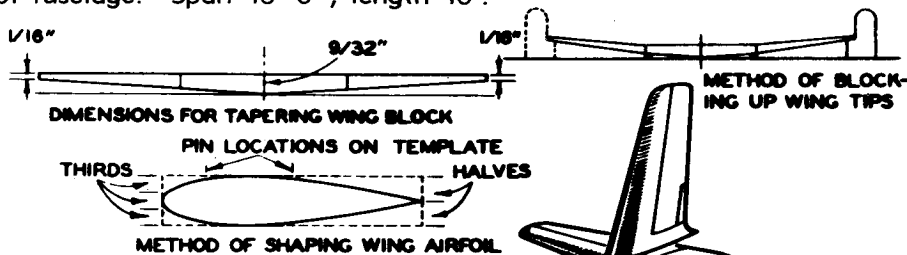
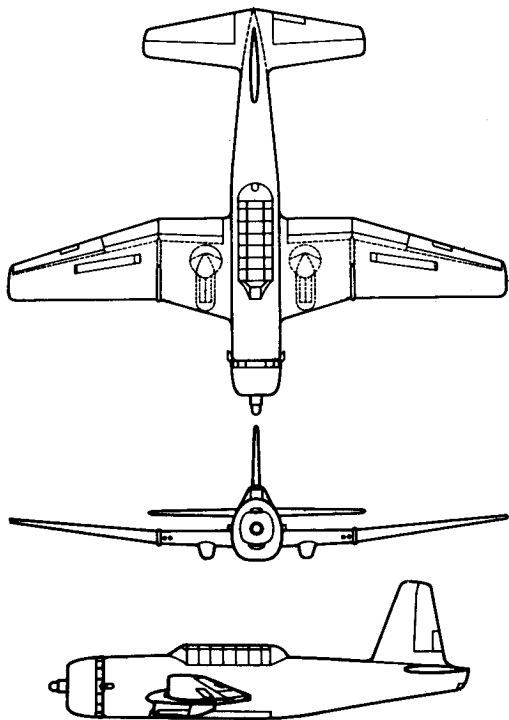


VULTEE A-31

The "Vengeance" is a U.S. Army two-place dive-bomber. A number of these planes are in service with the R.A.F. Equipped with flaps on top and bottom of wing for reducing speed when dive-bombing. Power plant consists of a 1600-H.P. Wright "Cyclone" 14-cylinder air-cooled, geared, and super-charged engine. Bomb load is carried inside of fuselage. Span 48' 0"; length 40'.
