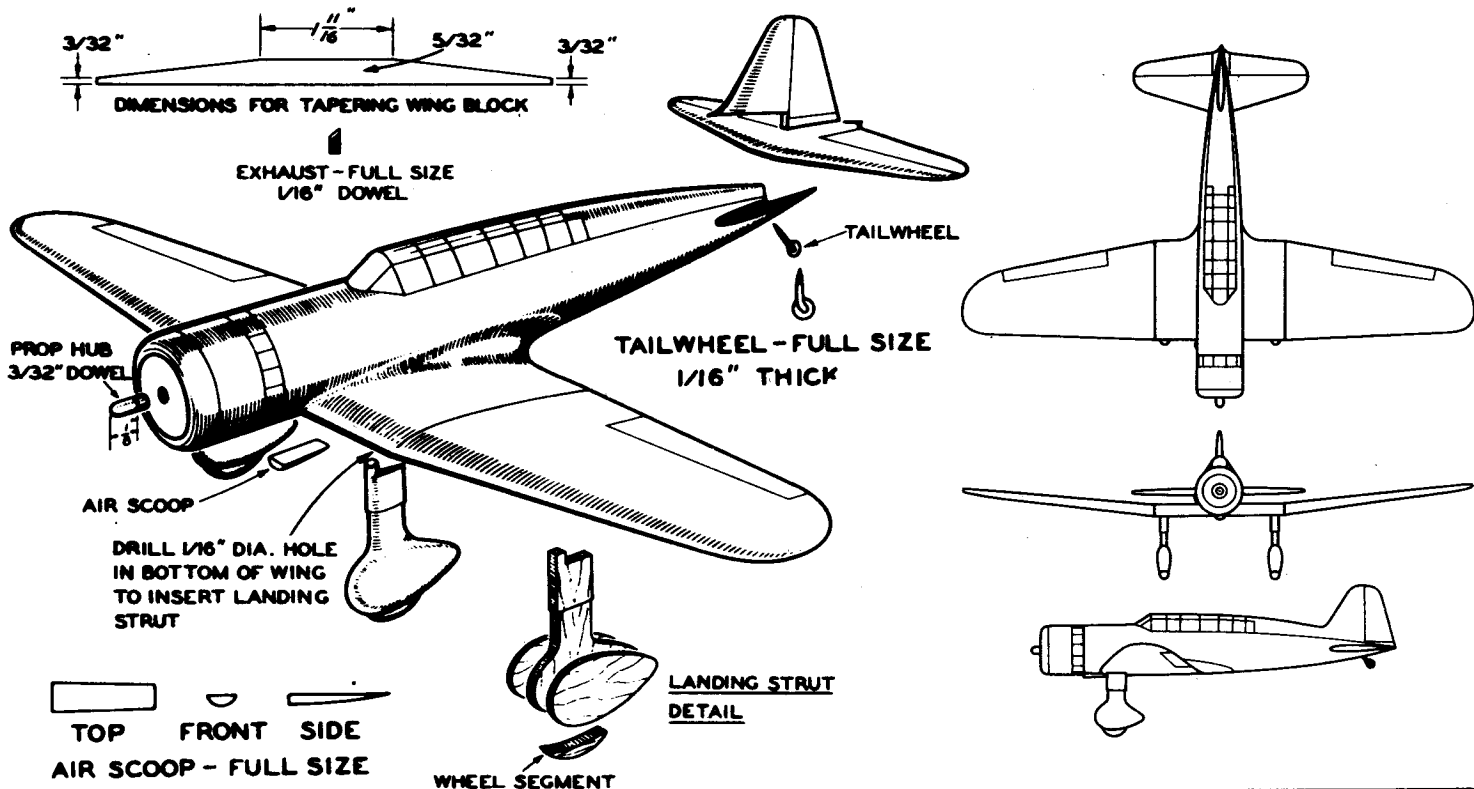



MITSUBISHI TYPE 97 A.L.B.

A two-place Japanese Army light bomber powered by an air-cooled radial engine. Before the war a forerunner of this type, named the "Kamikaze" ("Divine Wind"), made a demonstration flight from Japan to England. Span 40' 0"; length 28' 9".

Tail and pant cores	3/32" x 1 1/2" x 3 1/4"
Pant covers	3/64" x 7/8" x 1 1/2"
Wheel	1/8" thick
Propeller hub	3/32" dowel
