IDENTIFICATION

Radial engine low wing monoplane. Dihedral break beyond wide center section above the fixed landing gear struts. Large pants. Elliptical wing with dive brakes on extended struts (Junkers type). Tapered leading edge of tailplane. Long forward extension of fin. Span 47 ft. 7 in. length 35 ft. 5 in.

INTERESTING FACTS

The original Val, the Aichi 99, was in the sneak attack at Pearl Harbor. This improved version of the standard enemy dive bomber is also carrier based and is frequently encountered in our naval operations.
