



INTERESTING FACTS

In many ways this plane resembles the original Zero "Zeke". Its speed of about 330 m.p.h. is about 12 miles faster due to the reduced wing and greater power of the Nakajima "Sakae" engine. This Mark II Zero is more maneuverable than Mark I and climbs at about 2800 feet per minute. Two 7.7 mm. guns lay in the cowl and two 20 mm. cannon are in each wing.

BILL OF MATERIALS

- Fuselage 1x1½x5½
- Wing ¼x1¾x6¾
- Tail ¾x1¾x3¾
- Spinner 1t dowel

IDENTIFICATION

Radial engined low wing monoplane. Differs from original Zero in having squared wing tips and the forward air scoop changed from outside of the cowl and below, to inside and at top. The rear scoop remains under the cowl. Span 36 ft. 2 in. length 29 ft. 9 in.
