

JUNKERS Ju87b Commonly known as the "Stuka." This two-place dive-bomber is one of Germany's most publicized planes. Carries a 110-lb. bomb on sling beneath fuselage and two 100-lb. bombs beneath each wing. Span 45' 3"; length 45' 4".



1. GLUE DIHEDRAL IN CENTER SECTION UPSIDE DOWN
