Grant applications:

- ∞ Curtis will take care of the SfN grant, and Bernice will submit it. There is no deadline, and can be used towards activities on Brain Awareness Week.
- ∞ Bernice informed us that the SfN chapter start up grant, worth \$500, is available to us. Megan, our program administrator, will release this to us.
- ∞ Curtis, Ian, and Scott will work on the Walter Mackenzie Visiting Speaker Fund, AIHS lecture grant, and GSA lecture grant, and submit them by Dec. 1, to meet the appropriate deadlines. A couple of letters of support will need to be drafted for Dr. Kathryn Todd to sign, and we'll also need a detailed itinerary of flights and hotel bookings for Dr. Graziano. *Update by Scott (Dec 1): these three grants have been completed and submitted on Dec. 1. Ian has booked the flights and hotel for Dr. Graziano.*
- ∞ The plan is for Dr. Graziano will fly in on the night of the 24th, and fly out on the 27th. He'll stay at Campus suites for three nights.
- ∞ Nina has arranged for our student guest speakers to come up from the Universities of Lethbridge and Calgary. The ANNAE funding for their expenses has been approved by Dr. Peter Smith. The two guest speakers are Jenni Karl, and Ranjan Kumar.
- ∞ We are planning to send a program for NRD this year as a PDF to all attendees. An abbreviated program will be printed and available at Bernard Snell. Scott Travis and other volunteers will take responsibility for making the program up, since he will be responsible for the abstracts.
