Application and payment must be received on or before 16:00 MST, October 12, 2007. Late or incomplete submission will NOT be accepted without exception. Postmark of October 12 is NOT acceptable. You are NOT permitted to change your test site or test level after the Application Form has been submitted.

Application Form:

- ❖ Use a black ballpoint pen and fill out each form completely.
- ❖ Print clearly so that the forms can be easily read.
- ❖ The certificate will be issued exactly in the way that your name appears on the application form.
- ❖ If you use an English name as well as a legal name in another language, please be sure that the name in Section 3 of the Application Form matches the way you write in an official document such as your passport.

Deadline:

- ❖ The application deadline is **October 12, 2007**. Your completed application forms and payment form must be received by PTJC at the University of Alberta by 16:00 MST, October 12, 2007. **Postmark of October 12 is NOT acceptable.**
- ❖ If you are sending your application close to the deadline, we recommend that you use "Priority Post" (1 day service) or "Express Post" (2 day service) within Canada or a similar form of delivery from outside of Canada.

Check List (for Mail-in & In-person applicants only):

- Have you completed BOTH official Application Forms A and B?
- Have you completed the address label and the voucher (copy, front, and back pages)?
- Have you completed a Payment form?
- Have you attached 2 photos to your application form? Have you printed your name and test level on the back of each photo?
- If you move between the application date and February 2007 when the test results are mailed out, please be sure to provide PTJC with your new address.
- Have you made your payment in **CANADIAN** funds? American residents are required to pay by Canadian money order.
