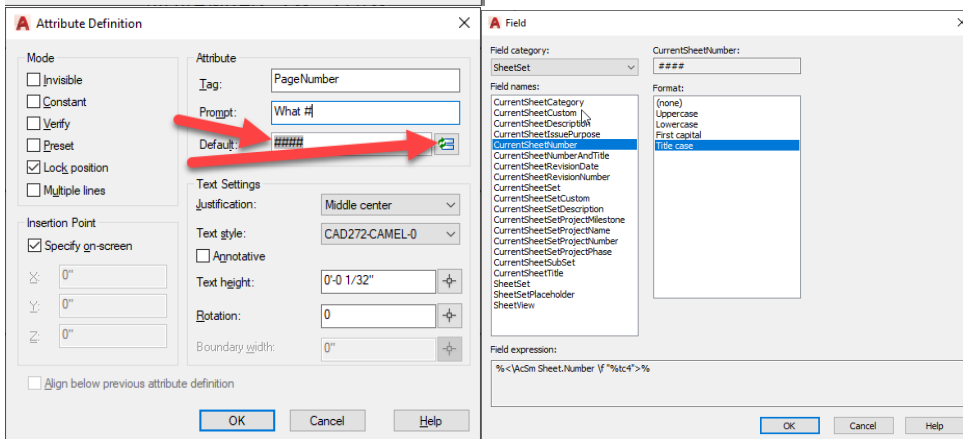
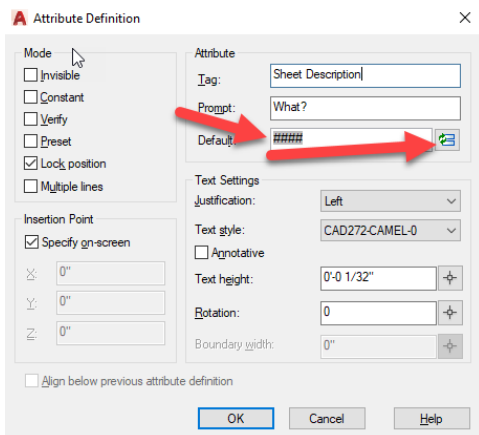


Sheet Set Fields in a Template File

- Start by opening a DWG file that contains your title block.
- In the Block Editor insert Sheet Set Fields such as CurrentSheetNumber
- And CurrentSheetTitle etc. etc.
- The mistake you are making is that you are not using attributes to do that. You are simply inserting Fields. You need to create an attribute and then insert the field as part of the attribute: ATTDEF



- Save and close the Block Editor.
- Save your Drawing as a TEMPLATE file such as "RoryTB2020.dwt"
- Open your sheet set
- Right click to get to Sheet Set Properties (have to have a file open)
- Either point to your new template or set Prompt for template to YES
