
The largest research institution in the province, the University of Alberta continues to increase its research capability, extend its industrial and government partnerships, and is a major engine of economic development through the transfer of University-based technology and knowledge to the commercial sector.

Research works in many ways, from bringing new technologies to market to providing employment to thousands of people in the Capital Region. Most of all, research works by accomplishing what a great university does best: creating and disseminating knowledge.

Canadian universities in research funding.




#### Research Works by attracting funding from many sources

In 1997/98 the University of Alberta received \$125.6 million from external sources for sponsored research:

- \$50.6 million in Canadian Government funding
- \$28.4 million from the Alberta Government, including \$15.3 million from the Alberta Heritage Foundation for Medical Research
- \$12.6 million from Canadian industry
- \$13.3 million from Canadian associations, foundations, institutes, local governments and individuals
- \$7.4 million from foreign governments, industries, associations, institutes, foundations and other sources
- \$13.3 million from endowment earnings for research

#### Research Funding 1988/89 to 1997/98 (in millions)


Since 1988/89, the University of Alberta has received more than \$895 million for research from external sources. Over the past five years alone, this funding total has increased by 40%.

#### **Research Puts People to Work**

University of Alberta research funding is responsible for almost 7,900 direct and indirect jobs in Edmonton and Alberta.

More than 2,720 University employees are paid through sponsored research:

- 1,073 are full-time
- 1,649 are part-time staff, of whom more than 1,000 are students
- their salaries and benefits totalled more than \$70,680,000 in 1997/98

An estimated 5,170 full-time and part-time jobs have been created indirectly outside the University from its sponsored research funding.

Economic Development Edmonton estimates that more than half of the conventions and conferences held in the Capital Region relate to the University of Alberta.

# because of Federal Networks of Centres of Excellence

University of Alberta researchers participate in all eleven of the Federal Networks of Centres of Excellence (NCEs), which link universities, industry and government across Canada in applied research and development. The eleven NCEs will bring at least \$35 million in research funding to the University through 2000.

As well, the University is the headquarters of the Prairie Centre of Excellence for Research on Immigration and Integration established in 1996.
